Sale of Chametz  
5776/2016**

I hereby appoint Rabbi David Zaslow as my representative to act on my behalf in the sale of all leavened goods and products belonging to me and the members of my household residing with me, whether or not these items are kept on my property and including all chametz\* of which I am aware and that of which I am not aware. Ownership and any right to use or have benefit from these products shall pass from me at noon on Friday April 22, 2016 and revert to me at sunset on the night of Saturday, April 30, 2016.

It is understood that during the entire Festival of Passover these products are no longer my own, that they will have been sold by Rabbi David Zaslow on behalf of all those who return this power of attorney. I agree that by **FRIDAY, April 22 at noon** I will have all the wheat and leaven based products that I own bagged, or boxed, and stored away in a secure area. I also agree not to eat any of these products during the days of Passover since they will be ownerless to me.

These foods are permitted on Passover.**
