I hereby appoint Rabbi David Zaslow as my representative to act on my behalf in the sale of all leavened goods and products belonging to me and the members of my household residing with me, whether or not these items are kept on my property and including all chametz\* of which I am aware and that of which I am not aware. Ownership and any right to use or have benefit from these products shall pass from me at 2 PM on Friday March 30, 2018 and revert to me at sunset on the night of Sunday, April 8, 2018.

It is understood that during the entire Festival of Passover these products are no longer my own, that they will have been sold by Rabbi David Zaslow on behalf of all those who return this power of attorney. I agree that by **2 PM, FRIDAY, March 30** I will have all the wheat and leaven based products that I own bagged, or boxed, and stored away in a secure area.
