


Explorations of Death & Dying

It begins with the true story of a little boy whose options were few, based on the western medical establishment and social laws, at a time when what he needed most were compassion and quiet time with his family for gentle closure. His story will open your heart as well as your eyes about the choices we may (or may not) have at the end of our physical journey.
