How can I reserve my place at the Shabbaton?

Your place will be reserved at the Shabbaton once you purchase tickets online at https://havurahshirhadash.org/product/shabbaton-2020/

Can I register over the phone?

We ask that everyone register online. If you are having trouble, call our office at 541-488-7716.

Will I be able to register at the door? There will be no walk-ins, however, we may sell segments come May if the event is not sold out. All registrations will be in advance, however.

Are there any discounts for Early Bird registration?

We have priced this Shabbaton with an already very reasonable fee in order to make it available to everyone. However, anyone who registers prior to March 15th will receive their own signed copy of our new Friday night Kabbalat Shabbat Siddur, created by Rabbi David Zaslow and Rabbi Emanuel ben-David with Reb Zalman's translations. (\$18 value).

Are there any scholarships available?

Limited work trades are available. If you are in financial need and are willing to work 2-3 hours over the weekend please e-mail requests to Ayala Zonnenschein at ayala@ashlandhavurah.org and write "work trade" in the subject line to arrange for a \$45 work trade discount. You will be notified closer to the time of the Shabbaton in regards to what exactly your work trade is. No heavy schlepping involved.

Are Friday night services open to the public?

If the event does not sell out, we may offer tickets to segments, to be purchased in advance only.

What is your policy on kids?

Due to space limitations, all children must be registered. Children 0-5 years of age are free and welcome to sit on their parent's lap or on the floor in the front of the sanctuary. The cost is \$40 per child ages 6-12. Children and teens from 13-18 pay just \$65.

What if I have to cancel after I've paid?

There is a \$25 cancelation fee if you cancel before March 15; \$50 cancellation fee if you cancel before May15; \$75 cancellation fee if you cancel between May 16 and June 5.

DIRECTIONS TO ASHLAND

From Interstate 5 coming from North: Get off at the first Ashland exit. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp. Go to the traffic light and turn left on Highway 99. Go through downtown Ashland. After you leave the downtown area turn left on East Main street (by the fire station) Go to the traffic light which is Mountain Avenue. Turn left onto Mountain Avenue. Go past the stop sign and over the railroad tracks. The Havurah is the second driveway on the left past the railroad tracks.

From Interstate 5 coming from the South: Get off at the first Ashland exit. The Freeway dumps you directly on Highway 99. Go straight several miles past Southern Oregon University. Turn right at the traffic light on Mountain Avenue. Continue on Mountain Avenue past the traffic light at East Main Street. Go past the stop sign and over the railroad tracks. The Havurah is the second driveway on the left past the railroad tracks.

SHUK
