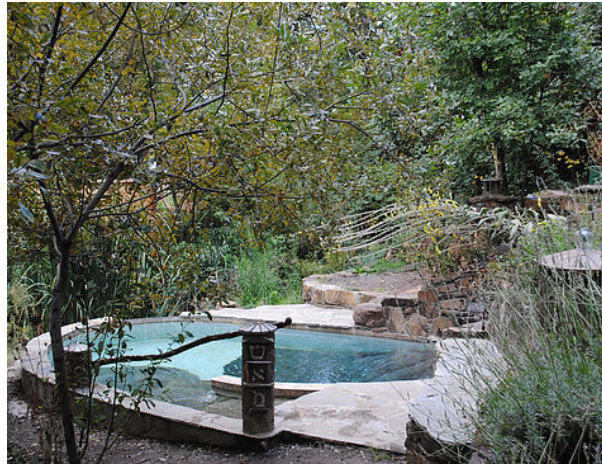

## The Kosher Mikvah at the Jackson Wellsprings in Ashland

On Friday, April 1 we are offering a kosher Mikvah experience in a natural hot springs (90+ degrees) to all Shabbaton attendees. Our Mikvah is located at the magical Jackson Wellsprings, located on Highway 99 in



Ashland. This Mikvah is the only one of its kind in Oregon, maybe in the Northwest. You can read about the Mikvah by [Clicking Here](#).

The fee for the Mikvah is \$18 per person. Mikvah participants are invited to use the spa facilities for a reduced rate of \$8 per person, payable at the Wellsprings office. We encourage you to take advantage of the healing pools at the Wellsprings. [CLICK HERE](#) to read more:

### Directions to the Jackson Wellsprings

The address for your GPS is Jackson Wellsprings is located at 2253 Highway 99 North, in Ashland Oregon. For written directions to Jackson Wellsprings [CLICK HERE](#)

From the Havurah turn left on Mountain Ave., at the bottom of the hill turn right on Hersey. Follow Hersey all the way till it meets the 99 and turn right. Drive till you pass intersection with turn off for I-5, pass that intersection and look for sign on the left.

*We encourage you to carpool to the Mikvah from the Havurah parking lot, to join in community and to save gas. It is not more than a 10 minute drive from the Havurah. Women who wish to carpool should gather at 1:30 PM, and men should meet at 3 PM in the Havurah parking lot.*

### Important Details for you to know:

The Woman's Mikvah, led by Cyrise Beatty Schachter, will begin PROMPTLY (not Jewish standard time) at 2:00pm, ending at 3:00 pm.

The Men's Mikvah, led by Rabbi David, will begin at 3:30pm, ending at 4:30pm. Bathing suits are optional. Bring your own towel (or two).

There is no requirement to shower prior to using the Mikvah as it is a natural pool with spring water constantly flowing. The Mikvah itself is 90+ degrees, yet it may be chilly and muddy outside depending on how our Ashland weather is that day. Please come prepared with a robe or heavy cover up, & good walking shoes.

You may feel free to bring your water bottle, but NO GLASS is allowed on the Wellsprings property.
