

April 5-7, 2019 Estelle Frankel Shabbaton Frequently Asked Questions

How can I reserve my place at the Shabbaton?

Your place will be reserved at the Shabbaton once you purchase tickets online at <https://havurahshirhadash.org/product/estelle-frankel-mft-shabbaton/>

Can I register over the phone?

We ask that everyone register online. If you are having trouble, call our office at 541-488-7716.

Will I be able to register at the door? We are expecting this event to be sold out. It is unlikely that registration will be available at the door. In the event that we have not sold out by March 15, a notice will be placed on the Havurah website to that effect.

Are there any discounts available after February 20?

Early Bird discount is available through February 20, 2019 only.

Are there any scholarships available?

Limited work trades are available. We don't want finances to be a reason to keep anyone away, so we do have a limited number of work trade opportunities available. If you are in financial need and are willing to work 2-3 hours over the weekend please e-mail requests to Ayala Zonnenschein at ayala@ashlandhavurah.org and write "work trade" in the subject line to arrange for a \$45 work trade discount. You will be notified closer to the time of the Shabbaton in regards to what exactly your work trade is.

Can I go to the Saturday night event only? In the event that the Shabbaton does not sell out, we will open up the Saturday night event to the public.

Does registration for the Shabbaton include Saturday night?

Yes. Registration includes tickets to the Saturday night event.

Are Friday night services open to the public?

Due to space limitations and the expectation that the Shabbaton will sell out, we cannot accommodate non-registered persons for Shabbat services at this point.

What is your policy on kids?

Due to space limitations, all children must be registered. Children 0-5 years of age are free and welcome to sit on their parent's lap or on the floor in the front of the sanctuary. The cost is \$40 per child ages 6-12. Children and teens from 13-18 pay just \$65.

What if I have to cancel after I've paid?

There is a \$25 cancellation fee if you cancel before February 20; \$50 cancellation fee if you cancel before March 15; \$75 cancellation fee if you cancel between March 15 and April 5.

Ashland Springs Hotel, 541-488-1700 or toll-free line 888-795-4545. (Good value, downtown location. Historic landmark hotel) *212 East Main is .9 miles away from the Havurah.*

If you would like to reserve rooms, you should do so as soon as possible. They are not holding any rooms for us, but have agreed to a discounted rate up until 30 days prior to the event. Just mention the Havurah to receive this discounted rate.

\$140 for Boutique Queen Rooms

\$160 for Deluxe Queen Rooms

\$170 Traditional King Rooms

Rates are exclusive of 11.8% Ashland Lodging tax.

All reservations must be guaranteed with a major credit card. Rates do include expanded continental breakfast, complimentary steam and sauna at Waterstone Spa & Salon, tea and cookies daily, free WiFi and parking, as well as concierge services and an onsite LARKS Restaurant.

Plaza Inn and Suites, 541-488-8900 (Deluxe – the most expensive in our listing)
98 Central is 1.07 miles away from the Havurah.

Rates: \$139 Double Queen Room or King room for 1-2 occupants. Rates do not include 11.8% Ashland city hotel tax. Rates are for up to 2 guests - \$10 will be added for each additional guest. Rates include complimentary European Continental Breakfast, late afternoon refreshment/snack and evening cookies and milk and PB&J fixings.

Bard's Inn, 1-800-533-9627 (Best Western – very close to downtown Plaza. *132 North Main is 1.14 miles away from the Havurah. Rooms will be released on February 22nd.*

Rates: \$115 for Standard King rooms per night. Rates do not include 11.8% Ashland hotel tax. Includes continental breakfast. Amenities include outdoor pool and hot tub. These rooms are available to be booked by calling our front desk directly and requesting a room in the "Havurah" room block, or they can be accessed on our website www.bardsinn.com by entering the dates of the event and using "Havurah" as the Access code.

Stratford Inn, 541-488-2151, *555 Siskiyou Blvd is .72 miles from the Havurah.*

Rates: \$120 per night for double queen. Rates do not include 11.8% Ashland hotel tax. Rooms are not being held, but if you wish to make a reservation just mention the Havurah and you will receive

DIRECTIONS TO ASHLAND

From Interstate 5 coming from North: Get off at the first Ashland exit. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp. Go to the traffic light and turn left on Highway 99. Go through downtown Ashland. After you leave the downtown area turn left on East Main street (by the fire station) Go to the traffic light which is Mountain Avenue. Turn left onto Mountain Avenue. Go past the stop sign and over the railroad tracks. The Havurah is the second driveway on the left past the railroad tracks.

From Interstate 5 coming from the South: Get off at the first Ashland exit. The Freeway dumps you directly on Highway 99. Go straight several miles past Southern

Oregon University. Turn right at the traffic light on Mountain Avenue. Continue on Mountain Avenue past the traffic light at East Main Street. Go past the stop sign and over the railroad tracks. The Havurah is the second driveway on the left past the railroad tracks.

SHUK

There will be a Shuk (market place) that will be set up for sales after the Saturday evening event at Temple Emek Shalom. Each vender will receive $\frac{1}{2}$ of a 6 ft. table to display their offerings in exchange for 20% of their gross profits. The Shuk will be open on Saturday night after the evening program, as well as on Sunday morning.
